Nakba survivors, around 20% of the Israel's population

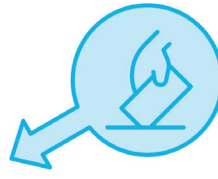


Family Unification



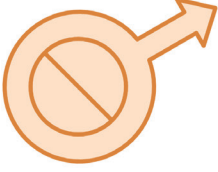
Cannot extend status to spouse from the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.

Civil and Political Rights



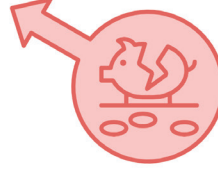
In practice 56 laws discriminate against them, underrepresented and politically suppressed.

Freedom of Movement



Access to both sides of the "Green Line". Travel allowed from airports in Israel.

Socio-Economic Rights



Undermined. Discriminatory planning system, high poverty and crime rates.

Above 350,000 Palestinians live in East Jerusalem

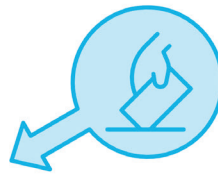


Family Unification



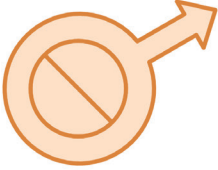
Frozen by Israeli Law since 2003. Children are not automatically registered.

Civil and Political Rights



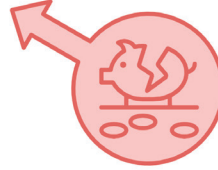
Inferior status that does not confer full citizenship, easily revocable by the Israeli Ministry of Interior. Over 14,500 East Jerusalem Status revoked from Palestinians by Israeli authorities since 1967.

Freedom of Movement



Hindered from moving freely even within Jerusalem, specifically where Jewish neighborhoods and settlements are located. Can access to both sides of the "Green Line". Travel allowed from airports in Israel using temporary Jordanian passports or Israeli-issued travel documents for international travel (Laisser-passer).

Socio-Economic Rights



undermined & highly discriminatory measures impact right to adequate housing, health, education, freedom of worship, among many others. Must prove discriminatory "Center of Life" requirement to benefit from socio-economic services.

Jewish- Israelis & Settlers in East Jerusalem and in Israel

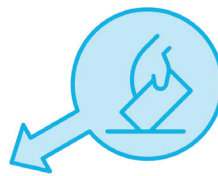

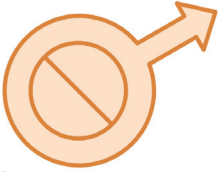
Children are automatically registered.

Civil and Political Rights



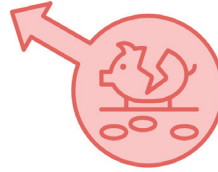
Full citizenship & political representation.
